## Acute weight gain

# Respiratory signs

- Tachypnea
- Cough
- · Moist lung sounds
- · Labored breathing
- · Diagnostic imaging findings consistent with pleural effusion, ascites, and/or pulmonary edema

#### Edema

- · Chemosis
- · Subcutaneous edema
- Organ edema and dysfunction (e.g., gastrointestinal signs, altered mentation, arrhythmia)

## Serous nasal discharge

**Cavitary effusion** 

Polyuria in the absence of renal failure

**Shivering** 

Restlessness
