We are seeking two volunteers: a Primary Representative to actively participate in committee activities and an Alternate Representative to step in if the Primary is unavailable.

Charge/Objective

The Clinical Practitioners Advisory Committee serves as an advisory committee to the Council on Biologic and Therapeutic Agents to ensure wide species-based, veterinary practitioner input on issues of biologic and therapeutic agents including but not limited to drug availability, distribution, use and residue control, and on quality assurance for products of food animal origin.

Time Commitment:

Term: Now-August 2027

This role requires active participation in committee activities throughout the year. The primary time commitments include:

- **Monthly Meetings:** One virtual committee meeting per month.
- **Major Meetings:** Two extended meetings annually, each lasting two days. One meeting is held virtually, and the other is in person in Chicago. (AVMA will reimburse committee members for authorized expenses.)
- **Subcommittee Involvement:** Participation in several subcommittee meetings per year, depending on the topics and assignments. Participation depends on the number of subcommittees that one participates in.
- **Ongoing Responsibilities:** Regular review and feedback on materials, with emails containing documents sent for review and comment approximately 3 to 5 times per month.

In total, this position requires a few hours per week to stay engaged with materials, attend meetings, and contribute effectively to the committee's goals.

Qualifications:

Must be a licensed veterinarian at an AAHA accredited practice.

AAHA Responsibilities:

Attend AVMA Clinical Practitioners Advisory Committee meetings as the AAHA committee volunteer and complete two annual board reports for the AAHA Board of Directors.
